Order of operation:

1. Create the background
 - a. One solid cloth
 - b. Pieced together cloth
2. Add the Applique
3. Add Embellishment
 - a. Embroidery
 - b. Sequins
 - c. Other items
4. Sew all the top parts together
 - a. (for example, each of you might be making a seperate section, bring them all together)
5. Make the "quilt sandwich"
6. Quilt stitch the layers together
 - a. Quilt stitches
 - b. Could also do your embroidery at this point instead
