






Cricut Maker

Different Blades / Drawing Tools



Use the Rotary Blade for cutting fabric.
Use the Bonded-Fabric Blade for cutting fabric with iron-on backing. Use
the Fine-Point Blade for cutting paper. Etc.





Cricut Design Space is an online free software for using the Cricut Maker. You

must create an account.

In the Cricut Design Space, select CANVAS from the left hand column.








The plotter cutter will cut around the black area of the image.


Upload the images as a .jpg,
.gif, or .png for best results.













You can resize your image, or add more images to your workspace.

When you are ready for cutting, click on "Make it" button.




Make sure you have the correct size mat selected. You can also mirror your image here if you want it to cut backwards.




Your computer will try to connect to the Cricut Maker via Bluetooth or USB. Once connected, you will be asked to select a material you are cutting.




The software will tell you which tool to have loaded in the Cricut Maker.


Load the correct tool.

You will see a blinking light on the machine. Press that button when you are ready to load the mat. (see next slides)

When it is ready and loaded, the "C" cricut button will blink. Press that button to begin cutting.
