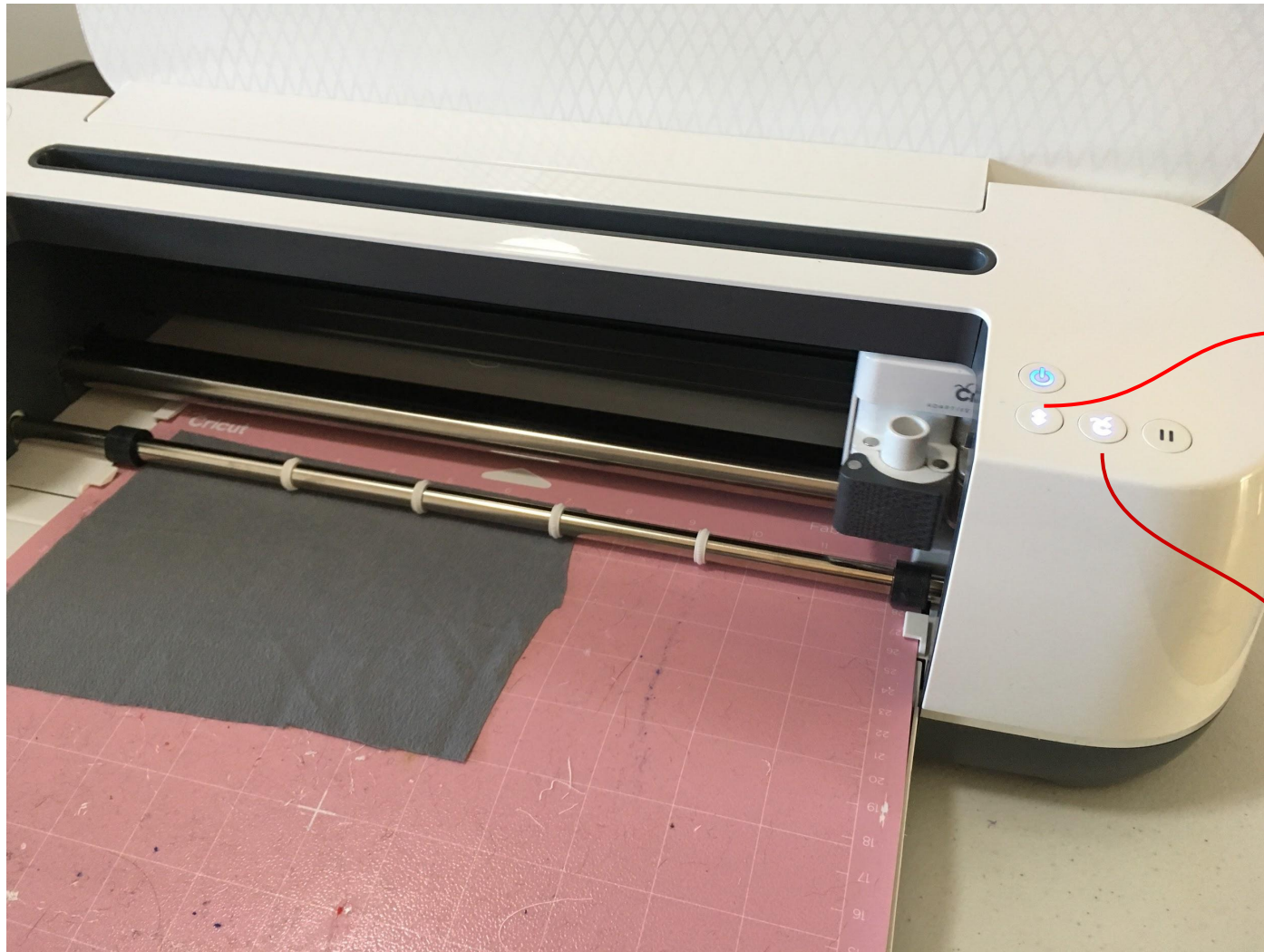
The software will tell you which tool to have loaded in the Cricut Maker.
