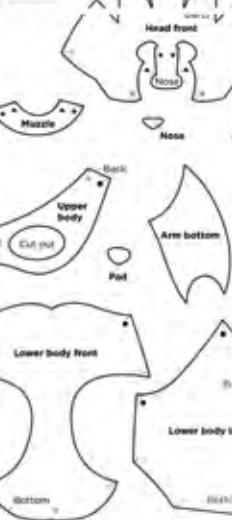
Rhinoceros Layout Diagram
